MESO is combining two important training topics - "Why We Ground" and "Hot Stick Training" into a two-day training session.

During the Grounding portion of the training participants will gain improved understanding and skills in the following areas:

1. Installing cluster bar;
2. Installing grounds;
3. What goes on first when installing & what is removed first when uninstalling;
4. What grounds are rated for when it comes to fault protection; and
5. Using the right size ground etc.

The Hot Stick Training will address:

1. Covering conductors/lines, cutouts, insulator, etc.;
2. Tying in & untying conductor on insulator (hot-ties & preforms);
3. Changing out a dead-end polymer;
4. Changing out insulator;
5. Moving conductor from wood or composite arm to layout arm (hot arm); and
6. Isolating a section of line using sticks.

Both journeyman lineman and apprentices will gain valuable knowledge and skills to deal with situations that may come up at any time. All MESO training is safety driven, and your employees will be able to take safe work practices home.
